

Tony's Books: An Autobiography

Introduction

The books listed are the books that were owned and read - in the order that they were read. There were many more books on other bookshelves but, because they were unread and therefore undated, they are not included on this list.

Sometime early in 1970, shortly after purchasing a first property, new bookshelves were installed and boxes of books were unpacked. Before placing the already read books carefully on the shelf, each one was signed and dated. Of course, not remembering the exact date on which the book was finished the first batches of books had a generic date. 1st January 1960 signified that these books were read before moving to London. Other books were identified as being read in the mid-sixties but the majority of books were dated 1st January 1970.

From this day forward, until no longer able to read, every book was signed, dated and shelved in chronological order. Unread books were stored on separate shelves. No one was allowed to touch or borrow the books. They stood as a kind of testament to identity. As the years passed and the collection grew, it seemed that the complexity of a personality could, indeed, be discerned.

The trajectory of a life, the exploration of interests and the search for understanding, the intellectual and literary influences, the pleasures of the text and the tunnels of escape, are drawn here through the simple mechanism of a list.
